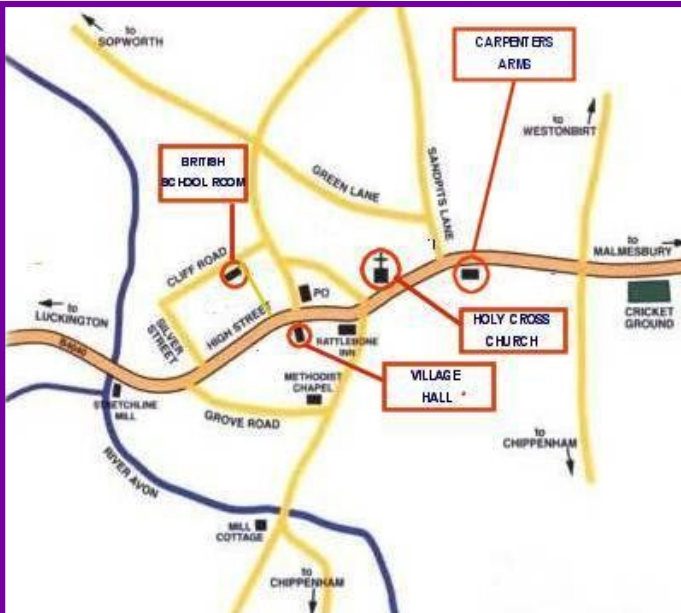
As well as the Art Exhibition, throughout the Festival there will be flower displays in the Church created by Sherston Church Flower Arranging Group.

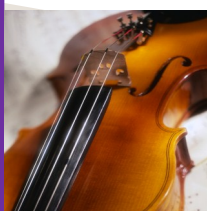
This year's theme is Heroes and Villains. Trail maps (£1) can be collected from the British School Room where teas will be

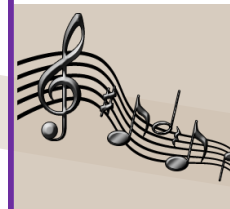
